

Release and Consent Form

- 1.) **I give my permission for the child listed on the reverse to attend the Progressive Agriculture Safety Day™.** I understand that one of the purposes of the Progressive Agriculture Safety Day™ is to teach participants to stay safe around farm sites, farm equipment and farm animals. During safety day, safety barriers will be in place, safety rules will be enforced, and participants will be closely supervised by safety day instructors and group leaders. However, I acknowledge that there is the possibility of accidents. I release the coordinators, instructors, volunteers, sponsors, the Central Nebraska Farm Safety 4 Just Kids Chapter, the Progressive Agriculture Foundation, and the Progressive Agriculture Safety Day™ program from all claims, in the event of injury to my child, unless the injury is the result of gross negligence or willful misconduct on the part of these parties.
- 2.) **First aid will be available at the safety day and medical and/or hospital care will be provided in case of serious illness or injury.** I understand that if serious illness or injury occurs, the emergency contacts listed will be notified. If it is impossible to reach the emergency contact(s), I give permission for emergency treatment as recommended by the attending physician.
- 3.) **I give my permission for photographs, audio, and video to be taken of my child** while engaged in safety day activities and for these images to be used by the Progressive Agriculture Foundation and the Canadian Agricultural Safety Association to promote safety in the media, on their websites, and in promotional materials.
- 4.) **I understand that my child might be asked to complete a written knowledge test before and after the safety day** to help evaluate the effectiveness of the Progressive Agriculture Safety Day™ program. Participation is voluntary, and my child may choose not to participate. I give permission for my child to participate in these evaluations.

CAMP FORMAT: The Progressive Agriculture Safety Day™ will be held Tuesday, June 3 at the Valley County Ag Complex located on the fairgrounds in Ord, Nebraska. Children in grades K-6 (on January 1, 2008) are invited. We cannot accept registrations for children who have not attended Kindergarten. Kindergarten through second graders should plan to arrive at 8:30 a.m. Their camp will end at 12:00 noon. Third through sixth graders should arrive at 11:45 a.m. and will be finished at 3:00 p.m. An adult will need to come to the Valley County Ag Complex to pick up your child at the time their camp concludes. We will give your child their goodie bag as you leave together. As always, this fun-filled day will include hands-on learning sessions focused on farm and home safety.
